Three Day Workshop on Essential Topics in Psychodynamic Psychotherapy

This three day workshop continues an ongoing series of educational opportunities for clinicians and others interested in learning more about Psychodynamic Psychotherapy. The series combines workshops on the *History and Development of Psychoanalytic Theory and Technique, Clinical Entities* and *Technical Issues in Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy*. The workshops offered will allow participants to accumulate credits towards the award of **An Introductory Certificate in**

Psychodynamic Psychotherapy.

Graham Kavanagh, MA (Cantab.), MA(Oxon.), MS, Phd.

Dr. Graham Kavanagh is a licensed psychologist and certified psychoanalyst. In addition to being in private practice in Manhattan since 1985, Dr. Kavanagh is a supervisor of psychotherapy in the Doctoral Clinical Psychology program at Columbia University. He is also both teaching faculty and supervisor of psychotherapy at the William Alanson White Institute of Psychiatry, Psychoanalysis and Psychology and was formerly Director Emeritus and Training and Supervising Analyst at the Long Island Institute of Psychoanalysis and Psychotherapy.

From 2004 to 2009 Dr. Kavanagh was Senior Lecturer and Supervisor in the Beijing Psychoanalytic Training Project at Beijing Institute of Technology, where he is an Honorary Professor. He has also been a guest lecturer at Peking University, South Western Normal University and Fudan University.

Day I (March 18, 2013) - History & Development of Psychoanalytic Theory and Technique (lectures 3 & 4 of a six lecture series)

Morning Session: <u>Fairbairn, Winnicott and the British School of Object Relations</u> <u>Theory</u>

Afternoon Session: Melanie Klein and the Modern Kleinians

Participants in this workshop will learn about major figures in the British School of Object Relations Theory and their theoretical and technical departures from classical Freudian theory and technique. The unique contributions of Melanie Klein will be considered independently, especially her attempts to apply fundamental Freudian concepts to the earliest years of infant development.

Day II (March 19, 2013) - Clinical Entities

The Psychopathology of Anxiety: Obsessive Compulsive Spectrum Disorders

Participants in this workshop will be introduced to a view of Obsessive Compulsive phenomena as points on a continuum of maladaptive interpersonal behaviour. This view will be contrasted with the psychiatric division of such phenomena into either biological or characterlogical disorders. Related clinical entities, such as phobias, will also be discussed. Clinical material will be included to illustrate the theoretical perspective presented.

Day III (March 20, 2013) - Technical Issues in Psychodynamic Psychotherapy

<u>Symptoms and their Meaning: Interpersonal Psychoanalytic and Freudian</u> <u>Perspectives</u>

Participants in this workshop will be invited to consider how a therapist's understanding of the meaning of a patient's symptoms affects his or her approach to the therapeutic process; Freud's medical model for understanding symptomatology will be contrasted with the Interpersonal Psychoanalytic view of symptoms as interactional phenomena with important transference-counter transference implications. Clinical material will illustrate the contrasting theoretical perspectives. ****
