Graham Kavanagh, MA (Cantab.), MA(Oxon.), MS, Phd.

Dr. Graham Kavanagh is a licensed psychologist and certified psychoanalyst. In addition to being in private practice in Manhattan since 1985, Dr. Kavanagh is a supervisor of psychotherapy in the Doctoral Clinical Psychology program at Columbia University. He is also both teaching faculty and supervisor of psychotherapy at the William Alanson White Institute of Psychiatry, Psychoanalysis and Psychology and was formerly Director Emeritus and Training and Supervising Analyst at the Long Island Institute of Psychoanalysis and Psychotherapy.

From 2004 to 2009 Dr. Kavanagh was Senior Lecturer and Supervisor in the Beijing Psychoanalytic Training Project at Beijing Institute of Technology, where he is an Honorary Professor. He has also been a guest lecturer at Peking University, South Western Normal University and Fudan University.

This workshop will introduce an orientation to the process of psychotherapy and the nature of therapist-patient interactions that is fundamental to the conduct of any effective psychodynamically oriented treatment.

This workshop presents an *Interpersonal Psychoanalytic* view of depression, which permits a broadly based conceptualization in which personality and relational factors are inextricably intertwined with the patient's unique psycho-biology.

Beginning Psychodynamic Psychotherapy: The Frame, Inquiry and Therapist- Patient Relationship

August 28th 2012

The primary focus of the morning session will be on the opening phase of therapy, employing the concepts of **Frame**, **Inquiry** and the **Therapist-Patient Relationship** to orient the therapist to his or her role as **Expert in Interpersonal Relations**. The presentation will also demonstrate how the use of these concepts permits the therapist further to develop the model used for the initial consultation in either a short-term intervention lasting several sessions or an ongoing intensive psychodynamic psychotherapy.

In the afternoon session, clinical material presented by the instructor and class participants will be used to illustrate conceptual and theoretical material outlined in the morning lecture. Time will also be made available for the discussion of related clinical issues.

Beginning Psychodynamic Psychotherapy: The Frame, Inquiry and Therapist- Patient Relationship

August 29th 2012

In the morning session, the nature of depressive phenomena will be discussed as they relate to a range of **Personality Disorder** diagnoses. Etiological theories, including **Mourning and Melancholia**, **Masochism** and **Anger** will also be reviewed. The morning presentation will conclude with a detailed exposition of the **Interpersonal Psychoanalytic** approach to the treatment of depression.

In the afternoon session, clinical material presented by the instructor and class participants will be used to illustrate conceptual and theoretical material outlined in the morning lecture. Time will also be made available for discussion of related clinical issues.
