

3 Day Workshop on Essential Topics in Psychodynamic Psychotherapy

This three day workshop is the first in an ongoing series that will combine workshops on the History and Development of Psychoanalytic Theory and Technique, Clinical Entities and Technical Issues in Psychodynamic Psychotherapy. The workshops offered will also allow participants to accumulate credits towards the award of *An Introductory Certificate in Psychodynamic Psychotherapy*.

Graham Kavanagh, MA (Cantab.), MA(Oxon.), MS, Phd.

Dr. Graham Kavanagh is a licensed psychologist and certified psychoanalyst. In addition to being in private practice in Manhattan since 1985, Dr. Kavanagh is a supervisor of psychotherapy in the Doctoral Clinical Psychology program at Columbia University. He is also both teaching faculty and supervisor of psychotherapy at the William Alanson White Institute of Psychiatry, Psychoanalysis and Psychology and was formerly Director Emeritus and Training and Supervising Analyst at the Long Island Institute of Psychoanalysis and Psychotherapy.

From 2004 to 2009 Dr. Kavanagh was Senior Lecturer and Supervisor in the Beijing Psychoanalytic Training Project at Beijing Institute of Technology, where he is an Honorary Professor. He has also been a guest lecturer at Peking University, South Western Normal University and Fudan University.

Day 1 (December 5, 2012) - History and Development of Psychoanalytic Theory and Technique (lectures I and II of a six lecture series)

Morning Session: Classical Freudian Psychoanalysis & the Development of Ego Psychology

Afternoon Session: From Sullivan to Contemporary Interpersonal Psychoanalysis

Participants in this workshop will learn about the Freudian origins of psychoanalytic theory and technique and its subsequent development by the Freudian Ego Psychologists. The Freudian and Ego Psychological perspectives will be contrasted with the viewpoints of Harry Stack Sullivan and of Contemporary Interpersonal Psychoanalysis.

Day 2 (December 6, 2012) - Clinical Entities

Paranoid Personality Disorder: Diagnosis and Psychodynamics

Participants in this workshop will learn about the diagnostic criteria for Paranoid Personality Disorder and about other disorders in which paranoid traits are evident. The psychodynamics of paranoid states will be discussed from the perspectives of Object Relations Theory, Classical Freudian Psychoanalysis and Interpersonal Psychoanalysis. Clinical material will be introduced to illustrate the various theoretical positions.

Day 3 (December 7, 2012) - Technical Issues in Psychodynamic Psychotherapy *Techniques of Intervention: Interpretation or the Detailed Inquiry?*

This workshop will expose participants to changing views on interpretation, the intervention that the Freudian analyst Ralph Greenson referred to as, "...the decisive and ultimate instrument of the psychoanalyst." The traditional Freudian perspective on interpretation will be outlined in detail and contrasted with the concept of the detailed inquiry developed by Harry Stack Sullivan and favoured by Interpersonal Psychoanalysis.
